Inclusion of South Ripley into Greenbank is entirely illogical and a blatant and clearly terrible proposal by all involved.

South Ripley is a central part of the Ipswich growth corridor, which is a critical aspect of the QLD state government's commitment to housing.

South Ripley shares no direct connection to Greenbank or Logan in any way, requiring transiting through two other districts as the shortest connection by any means. There is no transport, be it public or private, connection to Greenbank. South Ripley is connected only to Ipswich or Springfield and only logically makes sense to be included in one of these areas.

Separating the support services and decision making process from this area will cause a critical point of failure in the state government's ability to support the necessary development and expansion of housing to combat the cost of living crisis.

This is clearly an error which needs to be corrected and CANNOT remain as it is
