To whom it may concern,

I would like object to the new electorate boundaries suggested for South Ripley for the following reasons.

1. Community Identity:

We live, work, and play as part of Ipswich. Our schools, sports clubs, shopping, and community life are all Ipswich-focused — not Greenbank/Flagstone/Logan.

2. Council Alignment:

These suburbs are under Ipswich City Council, not Logan City. Grouping us with Logan-aligned areas splits us from our local governance and infrastructure planning.

3. Services & Infrastructure:

Medical services, shopping hubs, schools, and recreational centres are all in Ipswich (Yamanto, Springfield, Ipswich CBD). The proposed boundaries ignore our real-life connections.

4. Transport Links:

Roads and public transport connect us to Ipswich and Springfield, not Greenbank. Commuting and daily life naturally align with Ipswich.

5. Urban Planning & Growth:

Ripley Valley and surrounding areas are part of Ipswich's growth corridor, not Logan's. Future infrastructure, housing, and community services are tied to Ipswich planning.
