Dear Sir/Madam,

As a voter in the Burnett electorate, I am opposed to the proposed change to moved Agnes Water from Burnett to the Callide electorate.

My reasons for the objection are as follows.

We have nothing in common with the Callide electorate which is predominantly a farming/mining region.

Our community already has a foot in 2 areas Burnett for state (health and Education), but under Gladstone regional council and Central for (policing). This makes it very difficult as community to be heard and get the progress required for our area. Also being under the Flynn electorate federally.

The Callide electorate is an expansive area with no real transport links except road travel. This would make it very hard for the new member to get to our area and speak with the community. In the Burnett electorate we have far more in common as we are a coastal/tourism community similar to Bundaberg. We have turtle nesting areas as do other areas of the Burnett electorate. Our local member has been a regular visitor to our area and built up good repour with the community.

Moving us to the Callide electorate makes no sense and I feel it will have a big impact on voter engagement generally. In fact, if you really want to do our community a favour, move us into the Bundaberg Council region. Please do not put us in the Callide Electorate.
