I have read all the HILL submissions + some from neighbouring Electorates. Of the 754 submissions, 212 were from HILL. Considering the 93 Electorates, that is a VERY high response from HILL. Of the 488 of September 2025 submissions, 101 were from HILL. These numbers indicate great involvement, concern & commitment re this Redistribution. Many have been thoughtfully compiled, with common considerations which I do not need to repeat. Some non submissions are disappointing, ie, LNP and ALP. Very few are rude or selfish. Many are off topic.

Trust appears to be a big problem. There is much justified fear & anger due to the threat of the abolition of Hill. Gerrymander & or Political expediency was claimed by a lot of submissions, and it is difficult to disagree with them.

While I recognise the importance of complying with current Legislation, it is essential that the Commission complies with ALL the aspects of that Legislation. I'm not at all sure that this is being done, particularly in relation to the potential inequality of Representation between Urban & Regional Electorates, due to distances disadvantaging accessibility. The vast range of Industry and Business is an especially relevant consideration for ridiculously large Regional Electorates. Number of voters per Electorate is far from the only consideration. Voters are very concerned that all decisions made are fair & are seen to be fair.

We up here in Far North Qld are shocked that the LNP are proposing such a disjointed, divisive & unfair Redistribution. If it were fair & sensible, there would not be so much antagonism. Justice, equality & equity for all voters should be the goal of the Commission. Not prioritising any major or minor Party.

I anticipate that if HILL does end up being abolished, be it right or wrong, the LNP's role will not be forgotten or forgiven. There has been a lot of anger expressed.
