**Submission:**

As a resident of Brisbane, I am quite concerned by a number of the proposed electoral changes. I live and vote in moggill and so shall start with my concerns there, firstly the addition of multiple Ipswich suburbs into the electorate is greatly concerning as I, and many of there locally do NOT believe this is a proposition in the communities best interests. We already are a significantly large electorate as we span over mt cootha, which already makes community cohesion difficult especially with distribution of community upgrades and public transport systems, for myself public transport is a significant issue that I have brought up to my MP before, and I fear chapel Hill will be forgotten and disregarded with our community concerns by these new additions, I fail to see how the justification for this proposal is based on community needs as the ipswich suburbs proposed share very very little, to nothing in regards to community spaces and amenities with the remainder of moggill. I do not believe that this has been done with community interests in mind, but rather in an attempt to push for an LNP margin in future elections.

I am greatly concerned by the proposed merging of Gold Coast suburbs into the logan Beenleigh electorate as this definitely does not align with community interests, with very little shared community assets, and will result in fragmentation and upset towards the cohesion of the logan and gold coast communities.

I am also greatly upset at the name change for the indooroopilly electorate. Maiwar was chosen for a reason, I struggle to believe the name change is to create voter cohesion as justified by the LNP as many of the electorate proposed changes have very little to no regard for community and voter cohesion such as the moggill electorate changes. I struggle to believe that this commission does respect the traditional owners of this land like the little blurb on the bottom of this webpage suggests if you approve of this name change, the suggestion that Maiwar is difficult for our local communities to understand is very disrespectful and infantilising by the LNP proposal. The presentation that our communities are unable to understand our electorates under an Aboriginal name that has been used in legislation for close to 10years is upsetting and I am greatly disappointed by this suggestion morally I was a Maiwar resident for a significant amount of time and greatly value my community there and I feel this change does not represent the electorate fairly as it puts greater emphasis on the residents of the indooroopilly suburb, and it has been done without regards to the values of the community.

I am disappointed by these suggested remapping changes, and by these name changes and wish for the commission to take mine, and others complaints and concerns seriously. The concern that this proposed remapping has been largely

decided as a way to help LNP government future support is greatly concerning and I do believe significant consideration needs to take place, especially with regards to the legality of these designs as MANY do not seem to have the communities, or the voters interests in mind, which makes me believe that there is another group of stake holders (LNP government future security) that are mainly benefitting from these changes largely.
