As a private citizen, I have significant concerns about the proposal to redraw boundaries as outlined.

I do not find the justification sufficiently compelling for a majority of the proposed amendments and find the significant difference in voter preferences that would result if approved, of significant concern with relations to how these boundaries have been drawn.

To address this concern, the government would be required to rebalance to ensure prediction of party swings per seat would be then neutral overall, or undertake this as a proposal to the next election.

The current boundaries are one that has reflected and permitted many new generations of Queenslanders to fully comprehend and understand how and where their vote would flow. To modify this without clear voter mandate at an election is akin to bait and switch.
