I write to object to the proposed March 2026 redistribution on the grounds that it results in unfair representation. Under the Electoral Act 1992 the Commission must uphold "one vote, one value" [31†L108-L114] and consider community interests [38†L709-L714] . The current proposal does neither. For example, it abolishes the Labor-held district of \*Stretton\* while keeping all LNP-held seats intact [7†L93-L100] , which skews representation. Enrolment figures show that simply adjusting adjoining boundaries (rather than eliminating my district) would satisfy quotas [33†L158-L164] [35†L416-L422] without bias.

I respectfully urge the Commission to revise the boundaries to be impartial and community-based. Thank you for your consideration.
