Good Morning,

I write as a resident of Flinders Shire to acknowledge the Queensland Government's proposed electoral redistribution, including the suggested renaming of the current State seat of Traeger to Flinders.

While I understand the intention may be to reflect regional identity, I am concerned that renaming the State seat to Flinders could create confusion for residents, businesses, and organisations between State and local government responsibilities. Having lived for a number of years in the neighbouring town of Richmond, I know only too well the confusion that's caused by having multiple areas with the same name.

Flinders Shire has a strong and well-recognised identity, and the proposed State electorate boundary extends well beyond our Shire to incorporate many other shires. Using the same name may unintentionally dilute our community identity.

For these reasons, I believe it is preferable to retain a separate and clearly distinguishable name for the State seat.
