To the Head of the QRC,

As a business owner in Maroochydore, our business, Cruise Maroochy currently is within the Ninderry electorate.

1. We believe we should be, along with the entirety of Bradman Ave and other Maroochydore addresses, be within the Maroochydore electorate.

As much as I love Coolum, we are certainly not thought to be or included in the Coolum area.

We have a large river, the Maroochy River separating, clearly, Coolum & Maroochydore.

We feel we are in no man's land due to being in Maroochydore, yet part of the Ninderry boundary with the potential to be in the Coolum electorate.

If there was going to be redistribution, 270 Bradman Ave. The Cod Hole Jetty, home of Cruise Maroochy with significant historical, community cohesion, positive environmental awareness & commercial value within the Maroochydore region, should be in the Maroochydore Electorate.

2. We strongly object to the Ninderry electorate name being changed to Coolum as it has a boundary that over reaches into Maroochydore, along with other areas such as Kuluin, Kunda Park & Buderim.

The current proposal to change Ninderry to Coolum is shortsighted & can only cause further disconnect & confusion.

I have no objection to either MP Fiona Simpson or MP Dan Purdie.

We think highly of both.

I ask you both Fiona & Dan to endorse my letter & also send in to the QRC in support of my concerns
