## **Submission:**

The current Noosa electorate is 2.98% under the enrolment quota and, as such, requires adjustment to ensure electoral parity and integrity ahead of the 2028 State Election. Conversely, Ninderry is 9.33% *over* quota. Balance could be achieved by including the following areas into Noosa: Peregian Springs and Peregian Beach residents currently within Ninderry (this includes Peregian Breeze & West Peregian Beach/Peregian Beach acreage).

I urge the Queensland Redistribution Commission committee to adopt this boundary realignment for the Noosa State Electorate, based on the following outcomes:

- 1. <u>Community Identity</u> These suburbs already function and identify as part of Noosa, with shared social, economic, and geographic cohesion.
- 2. <u>Quota Balance</u> This proposal resolves both the under-quota status of Noosa and the over-quota burden in Ninderry.
- 3. <u>Electoral Fairness and Representation</u> This alignment ensures that residents are represented in a way that reflects their lived experience, improving local advocacy and cohesion.
