**Submission:**

The Redistribution Commission proposes a realignment of the Morayfield and Kurwongbah boundaries. I strongly disagree with the proposal.

The current boundary follows a natural watercourse, Burpengary Creek. The boundary joins Burpengary Creek where it crosses O'Brien Rd then follows the creek to where it crosses Oakey Flat Rd. From a topographical perspective this makes complete sense. Whereas the proposal is to move that part of the boundary line to Burpengary Rd, Young Rd and Oakey Flat Rd. effectively dividing a suburb.

Additionally it will unacceptably place the local member's electorate outside his own electorate.

If there is to be any realignment of the Morayfield/Kurwongbah boundaries, in that area, I suggest moving the small section of boundary that bisects Delaney Rd and placing it onto the creek line, leaving the rest of that section as it is. In that way Burpengary Creek becomes the boundary along that entire section.

All in all the proposal as it stands is nothing but a complete waste of money. To affirm, I object in the strongest sense to the current proposal to the realignment of the Morayfield and Kurwongbah boundaries.
