Submission:

I am writing to object against the redistribution of the Aspley electorate, particularly the revised eastern border that will run through Newman Rd and Innes St, Geebung, effectively splitting the suburb's representation into two. Geebung has little in common with the rest of the Nudgee electorate, which sits largely east of the North Coast rail line and Sandgate Road. Moving the eastern parts of Geebung to Nudgee the neighbouring electorate disregards its strong ties to Aspley. These ties include shared school catchments, sporting facilities, and community infrastructure.

Geebung's natural community links run west toward Aspley, Bald Hills and Zillmere, not east, where residents are separated by a rail line, an industrial area, Sandgate Road, and a major golf course before any residential areas are reached.
