## **Submission:**

I object to the proposed changes to the Pine Rivers electoral boundaries. Instead of using natural boundaries such as roads or rivers as the electorate largely now does, this proposal slices through communities property boundary by property boundary. Pine Rivers is much more than a community between two rivers or the remnants of an old shire. We are an inter-connected and cohesive community with strong links and relationships. Stripping away our town centre (removing Strathpine, along with Lawnton and Bray Park) and reshaping the electorate around political convenience risks breaking apart the heart of our community. Many Pine Rivers-branded clubs, organisation and businesses would be negatively affected by the boundary change. I urge the electoral commission to minimise the changes to the current boundaries.
