Dear Sir/Madam,

I write with great concern that the Queensland State Government is considering removing the Hill Electorate from the Queensland Electoral system. This would be dishonouring Far North Queenslanders with them receiving inadequate representation in parliament. At the moment Hill contains 41,704 to 42,491 voters which is the average size required to ensure "one vote, one value" in Queensland. This shows a gross lack of respect to North Queenslanders to take away their right for one vote to equal one value.

I am also very concerned that a gerrymander is being considered so that the Liberal/National party is favoured. And consequently I am concerned that Mr Shane Knuth (member for Hill) is being targeted. Mr Knuth does a wonderful job of looking after and representing his constituents. He does not discriminate against people who vote for a different party from his own. To him everyone deserves to be heard. People of Far North Queensland, including us people residing in Hill deserve a fair go and a fair hearing.
