Dear Queensland Redistribution Commission Chairperson,

It has been suggested by some people (including the Australian Labour Party) that Highfields should be moved out of the Toowoomba North electorate and combined with Nanango or Condamine. I do not support moving Highfields into Nanango or Condamine or any other combination of areas west of Toowoomba. As a Highfields resident of 8 years, I strongly identify with Toowoomba where many of the services I use and communities I am involved in are co-located. My local government council is the Toowoomba Regional Council so it would be disruptive and confusing to be moved to an electoral district outside of Toowoomba, disconnected from the place where I live. I feel that Highfields should remain in the Toowoomba North electorate.
