## Hello

Im requesting these factors be considered when determining any Maiwar boundary redistribution please.

As a long term resident of both Sherwood, Graceville, Chelmsford and currently Oxley I make this submission for your consideration.

Please retain the Maiwar hard boundary as it is bounded by the Brisbane river currently.

Apart from a blatant attempt at making the seat friendlier to the LNP at the cost of good sense and natural communities of interest, a single bridge does not create a cohesive community between Indooroopilly and Chelmer.

Population growth can be best accommodated through the much more logical transfer of Fig Tree Pocket, already disconnected from the rest of Maiwar, out of Maiwar and in to Moggill while gaining more of the urban neighbourhoods near Milton into Maiwar.

LNP has proposed to rename Maiwar from its current First Nations name to the old name of Indooroopilly and return to the boundaries when the LNP last won the seat in 2015 — which would involve moving large amounts of Auchenflower and Toowong into Cooper while jumping the Brisbane River to put Chelmer, Graceville and Sherwood in Maiwar. This is an unnecessary and ill advised proposition.

I oppose greatly the splitting of the Maiwar peninsula. The river is a natural boundary for this electorate and should not be changed.

Please retain that Gard boundary Thank you for considering my submission
