Hello,

I have sought and recieved endorsement from Narangba Valley SS P&C regarding proposed boundary changes to our State Electorate on Kurwongbah.

RE: Proposed changes to Kurwongbah Electorate boundaries

I write on behalf of the Narangba Valley State School P&C to express concern about the changes proposed to Kurwongbah electorate boundaries – specifically the splitting of the Narangba Valley community into different electorates using Young Road, Narangba, as a border.

If these changes go ahead, our school will be on the very edge of the Morayfield electorate, despite being only metres away from the State Member for Kurwongbah, Shane King's office. Further, our students and families are drawn almost wholly from the current electorate of Kurwongbah, and the State Member provides graduation letters and sponsors our school events. Under the proposed boundaries, our school community would be split between two electorates complicating protocols for these services and donations.

The changes proposed for Narangba don't appear sensible– please reconsider any split in our suburb.
