Submission:

The submission I make for Brisbane City-South State Electorates affects the seats of Toohey, Miller, Stretton, Mt Ommaney, Inala, Mansfield.

This Centers around the Seat of Toohey being abolished with the electors being distributed across seats becomes current Stretton Electorate expands into Robertson, Sunnybank, MacGregor and parts of Coopers plains East of Orange Grove Road. Its new borders are west from Exit 11 to Exit 14. Loses 8 Mile Plains to Mansfield and West of Orange Grove Road and the suburbs of Salisbury, Moorooka, Rocklea and Nathan Uni Campus to Miller. It should be renamed to the electorate of Sunnybank and Stretton to distinguish the change and signify the new electorate with both suburbs. Springwood, Woodridge and Waterford boundaries have also been impacted. Waterford will run along Beenleigh Road into parts of Kuraby covering Kuraby Train Station and Wally Tate Park, Woodridge gains parts of the Karwatha Forest from Stretton and Springwood cross the Pacific Mwy from Exit 20 to Underwood and heads west along Underwood Road till it reaches Warrigal Road.

Other notable changes to mention as part of my submission.

Mansfield takes Eight-mile plains from Toohey.

Miller gains parts of Coopers Plains all of Salisbury, Griffith Uni nathan Campus, Rocklea and Moorooka from Toohey. Loses Graceville and Sherwood to Mt Ommaney.

Mt Ommaney gains Sherwood and Graceville from Miller

Inala Gains parts of Heathwood along Blunder River from Blunder Road/Old Blunder Road up to Logan Mwy.

Algester Gains all of Drewvale off Stretton from Illaweenaa St to the Brisbane and Logan Council Border along Trinty Way.
