Primarily, I object to the dissolution and redistribution of the electorate of Hill.

Secondly the realignment of the other electorates (Cairns, Cook, Mulgrave and Barron River) need to have greater focus on electors access to the major centre rather than the population distribution within set boundaries.

More importance needs to be given to a MP area of responsibility (and is geographic diversity) than to any population within this boundaries. Meaning special consideration needs to be allowed in the rural and regional electorates that allow more Parliament representatives and lower electorate population. Without this, The state government is represented too heavily by the areas in South East Queensland.
