In Reference to Greenslopes:

I do not beleive it is a good idea to split the suburb of Coorparoo between Bulimba and Greenslopes. Especially at the LNPs proposed point, across from Coorparoo SS and Coorparoo Central shops. It would be splitting a cohesive community and mixing in Coorparoo with very disparate groups. Camp Hill has a lot in common with Stones Corner - it's the closest spot for an aldi, excellent op shopping, walking along the river, and convenient PT to the city. Down through to the MTG shops are (and Krista Adams Holland Park Ward Office) is the local bunnings, more local shops and cafes, and these are all easily accessible down Boundary Road. Going in the opposite direction, Whites Hill is where the local sports fields are, and both Whites Hill and Mt Gravatt are the local accessible greenspace.

Bulimba and Balmoral on the other hand, are very distant - there's almost no reason to go there for the average person outside of family members etc. There are closer local services, ammenities, and schools. Coorparoo SS is one of the largest schools in the area, and is an institution for locals. I might not have gone there myself, but I know so many people who did, or have kids there, or both.
