Submission:

Oppose border modifications to Moggil electorate that cross the Brisbane river. Colleges crossing is the only connection between the two sides of the river in this area. The south side has far more integration with the Ipswich area than with areas such as Kenmore, which it would share an electorate with in the proposed redistribution.

Oppose border modifications to Mt Ommaney/Inala. As resident of this electorate, I know that Darra and Sumner are far more integrated with the Oxley and Mt Ommaney areas and is cleanly separated from Inala by Ipswich Road. Moving these suburbs to Inala makes little sense. This modification very obviously pushes the more working class suburbs into the safe Labor seat of Inala and brings the more affluent Chelmer into Mt Ommaney, effectively consolidating more of Labor's voters into a single electorate and diluting the votes of the remaining suburbs in a clear effort to gerrymander.
