Miller and Mount Ommaney

Because one of the inner south's seats will need to be abolished to make room for two new outer suburban seats, **Miller** and **Mount Ommaney** have to have some pretty significant shifts in their boundaries. The Greens and many other submissions recommend **Miller** gaining Moorooka and Salisbury which have a clear community of interest with Annerley up Annerley Road while shifting Sherwood and Chelmer into Mount Ommaney because Oxley Creek forms a natural barrier. The LNP however want to move Sherwood and Chelmer into Maiwar to make their margins look better.

Key changes to mention to support

- The Chelmer peninsula is very poorly connected to elsewhere in **Miller** and moving to Mount Ommaney is the clearest change

Key changes to mention to oppose

- The Oxley Reach peninsula is a clear community with common interests and should not be split across multiple electorates
- **Boundaries should not cross the Brisbane River.**
