Submission:

The western part of the Brisbane City suburb Indooroopilly, located on the western side of the Western Freeway (Centenary Motorway), is informally known as the Indooroopilly Woods precinct (see Attachment 1 – Queensland Globe Map – Indooroopilly Woods precinct). This area was first developed into residential dwellings during the 1950s and was initially connected to the broader Indooroopilly suburban area by two access roads – Julie Street and Russell Terrace (see Attachment 2 – Pre Western Freeway 1976 Aerial Photograph).

When the Western Freeway was constructed during 1976/1977, two access road linkages were maintained to continue the precinct's connection with the broader suburb. Russell Terrace continued its original alignment with the Western Freeway constructed using an overpass. However, access via Julie Street was permanently closed, and a new overpass extending Waverley Road to connect with Coverdale Street approximately 150 meters to the north was constructed. A pedestrian tunnel was also built that links East-West underneath the Western Freeway between Carinya Street and Moore Park providing local active transport connections.

The Indooroopilly Woods precinct remains physically separated from areas to the West and South (the suburb of Chapel Hill) by a mixture of remnant bushland and green space surrounding the Green Hill Reservoir and Clarina Street Park across its Northern, Western, and Southern flanks. This division is also evident in the current boundary alignment of the Locality of Indooroopilly (see Attachment 3 – Indooroopilly Woods precinct natural boundary). With the intentional preservation of the precinct's road and pedestrian tunnel access towards the East, the historic construction of the Western Freeway was deliberately not intended to create a physical separation or disconnection of the precinct with the broader suburb of Indooroopilly.

The precinct has continued to retain social, community, and transport connections to the broader Indooroopilly suburb through state government service provision via Primary and Secondary School catchments, public transport routes, and main roads (see Attachment 4 – Edmap Queensland school catchment map – Indooroopilly State School, Attachment 5 – Edmap Queensland school catchment map – Indooroopilly State High School, Attachment 6 – Translink 415 Service).

From an economic perspective, the predominant connection for the Indooroopilly Woods precinct is towards the East with the Indooroopilly Central Business Centre, with secondary connections to the Taringa and Toowong



business/shopping precincts towards the North-East. The precinct connects more broadly to the Brisbane Central Business District through these centres to the North-East.

Prior to the 2017 Queensland State electoral redistribution, the Indooroopilly Woods precinct was included in the electorate of Indooroopilly (Attachment 7 – Queensland State Electorate of Indooroopilly). When the new electoral district of Maiwar was established, the Indooroopilly Woods precinct was recast into the electoral district of Moggill (see Attachment 8 – Queensland State Electoral District of Moggill).

The Indooroopilly Woods precinct maintains little to no economic, social, community, or significant travel connections with the Moggill electorate, with the majority of these connections in the complete opposite direction towards the East and North-East in the electorate of Maiwar. Furthermore, instances of state government service provision are typically provided within or through the electorate of Maiwar (see Attachment 9 - Queensland State Electoral District of Maiwar).

Considerable efforts were undertaken to ensure that the construction of the Western Freeway would not create a physical barrier between the Indooroopilly Woods precinct and the wider suburb of Indooroopilly. Using this infrastructure as a feature for an electoral boundary in this area conflicts with the original intent and the social compact established with the local community at the time of the Freeway's development.

It is requested that the Indooroopilly Woods precinct be redistributed into the electorate of Maiwar or a similar electoral boundary outcome that again connects the precinct with the broader suburb of Indooroopilly, which is a region more representative of its state-based interests and connections.

The Indooroopilly Woods precinct encompasses three Australian Bureau of Statistics Statistical Area Level 1 (SA1) districts: 30403109406, 30403109403, and 30403109402 (see Attachment 10 - ABS Maps SA1 boundaries intersecting with the Indooroopilly Woods precinct). Collectively, these areas contain a current estimated population ranging from 600 to 1200 individuals, reflecting the average of 400 residents per SA1 and the precinct's low-density residential zoning. From an electoral quota standpoint, such an increase, when added to the Maiwar electorate's projected enrolment of 43,950 as of June 2032 (Queensland Electoral Commission Discussion Paper, July 2025), would remain well inside the electorate's quota requirements. The Moggill electorate's projected enrolment of 37,011 as of June 2032 has been flagged in the discussion paper as requiring a redistribution by 2032. A loss of the Moggill electorate's quota from removing the Indooroopilly Woods precinct could be potentially offset with a change to the Moggill electorate's boundary to include the Locality of Fig Tree Pocket. Fig Tree Pocket has a current-day population count of 4608 people (ABS 2024 SA2 statistics). In this instance both Maiwar and Moggill electorates would have a projected 2032 enrollment of 40,000 and both be within quota.



- 4. Raise your hand so the driver knows to stop.
- 5. On the bus find your seat quickly. If you need to stand, hold onto a handle.
- Ring the bell to let the driver know to stop at the next stop for you to get off.
 Stay seated until the bus stops and tap off with your go card as you get off.
- Wait for the bus to move away and check the road is clear before crossing the road.
